PARIŠKA DEKLARACIJA

Stojimo u odlučujućem momentu po pitanju odgovora na AIDS. Zahvaljujući naučnim otkrićima, aktivnosti zajednice i političkoj predanosti, imamo realnu mogućnost da ostvarimo Ciljeve održivog razvoja o okončanju AIDS epidemije do 2030. godine. Gradovi su teško pogođeni ovom epidemijom, ali prednjače u reagovanju na HIV. Gradovi su u jedinstvenom položaju da vode Fast-Track akcije koje teže da postignu 90-90-90 cilj, kao i ostale ciljeve. Postizanje ovih ciljeva će nas dodatno približiti konačnom cilju da više ne bude novih infekcija HIV-om i smrtnih slučajeva uzrokovanih AIDS-om.

Prepoznajemo da okončanje epidemije AIDS-a zahtjeva sveobuhvatan angažman koji svim ljudima omogućava pristup kvalitetnom očuvanju i poboljšanju života, liječenju, njezi i uslugama koje se odnose na HIV, tuberkulozu i virusni hepatitis. Integrisanje ovih usluga u usluge seksualnog, reproduktivnog i mentalnog zdravlja, od presudnog je značaja za postizanje univerzalnog pristupa zdravstvenoj zaštiti.

Možemo eliminisati stigmatu i diskriminaciju ako svoje postupke gradimo na naučnim dokazima. Shvatanje da uspješno liječenje HIV-a i suzbijanje virusa sprječavaju prenos HIV-a (nedetektovan=neprenosiv) može pomoći u smanjenju stigme i ohrabivanju ljude koji žive sa HIV-om da započnu sa liječenjem HIV-a i da se toga pridržavaju.

Uz međusobnu saradnju, gradovi mogu ubrzati lokalne akcije ka okončanju epidemije AIDS-a, tuberkuloze i virusnog hepatitisa na globalnom nivou do 2030. godine. Prema Novoj Urbanoj Agendi mi ćemo iskoristiti naš domet, infrastrukturu i ljudski kapacitet kako bismo izgradili pravedniju, inkluzivnu, prosperitetniju i održivu budućnost za sve naše stanovnike, bez obzira na starosnu dob, pol, seksualnu orijentaciju, društvene i ekonomske okolnosti.

MI, PREDSEDNICI OPŠTINA, OBAVEZUJEMO SE:

1. Okončaćemo epidemiju AIDS-a u gradovima do 2030. godine

Obećujemo se da ćemo do 2030. ostvariti ciljeve 90-90-90 i druge Fast-track ciljeve. To će nas izvesti na put ka okončanju epidemije AIDS-a, tuberkuloze i virusnih hepatitisa do 2030. godine. Obećujemo se da ćemo obezbijediti kontinuirani pristup kvalitetnim uslugama testiranja, liječenja i prevenciji HIV-a, uključujući preekspozicionu profilaksu (PrEP), kao podršku sveobuhvatnom pristupu suzbijanja AIDS-a koji se također bavi tuberkulozom, virusnim hepatitisom, seksualno prenosivim infekcijama, mentalnim zdravljem,

PARIS DECLARATION

We stand at a defining moment in the AIDS response. Thanks to scientific breakthroughs, community activism and political commitment, we have a real opportunity to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals target of ending the AIDS epidemic by 2030. Cities have been heavily affected by the epidemic and have been at the forefront of responding to HIV. Cities are uniquely positioned to lead Fast-Track action towards achieving the 90-90-90 and other targets. Attaining these targets will put us on a trajectory towards getting to zero new HIV infections and zero AIDS-related deaths.

We recognize that ending AIDS requires a comprehensive approach that allows all people to access quality life-saving and life-enhancing prevention, treatment, care and support services for HIV, tuberculosis and viral hepatitis. Integrating these services into sexual, reproductive and mental health services is critical to achieving universal access to health care.


We can eliminate stigma and discrimination if we build our actions on scientific evidence. Understanding that successful HIV treatment and viral suppression prevents HIV transmission (Undetectable = Untransmittable) can help reduce stigma and encourage people living with HIV to initiate and adhere to HIV treatment.

Working together, cities can accelerate local actions towards ending the AIDS, tuberculosis and viral hepatitis epidemics globally by 2030. As called for by the New Urban Agenda, we will leverage our reach, infrastructure and human capacity to build a more equitable, inclusive, prosperous and sustainable future for all our residents, regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation and social and economic circumstances.

WE, THE MAYORS, COMMIT TO:

1. End the AIDS epidemic in cities by 2030

We commit to achieve the 90-90-90 and other Fast-Track targets, which will put us firmly on the path to ending the AIDS, tuberculosis and viral hepatitis epidemics by 2030. We commit to provide sustained access to quality HIV testing, treatment and prevention services, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), in support of a comprehensive approach to ending AIDS that also addresses tuberculosis, viral hepatitis, sexually transmitted infections, mental health, substance use disorders, and comorbidities associated with aging with HIV. We will eliminate HIV-related stigma and discrimination.

2. Postavićemo ljude u središte svega što radimo

Usmjerićemo svoje napore na sve ljude koji su podložni HIV-u, tuberkulozi, virusnom hepatitisu i drugim bolestima. Pomoći ćemo u ostvarivanju i poštovanju ljudskih prava svih pogođenih ljudi i nikoga nećemo zanemariti u našim gradovima u slučaju AIDS-a, tuberkuloze i virusnog hepatitisa. Značajno ćemo uključiti ljude koji žive s HIV-om u donošenje odluka oko politika i programa koji utiču na njihov život. Djelovaćemo lokalno i u partnerstvu s našim zajednicama kako bismo doprinijeli globalnoj podršci za zdravo i otporno društvo i održivi razvoj.

3. Razmotrićemo uzroke rizika, ranjivosti i prenošenja

Koristićemo sva sredstva, uključujući opštinske pravilnike i programe, za rješavanje faktora koji ljude čine podložnim HIV-u i drugim bolestima, uključujući i zakone koji diskriminiraju ključnu populaciju. Osiguraćemo da ljudi pogođeni HIV-om ravnopravno učestvuju u građanskom, političkom, društvenom, ekonomskom i kulturnom životu bez predrasuda, stigmati, diskriminacije, nasilja ili progona. Sarađivaćemo blisko i sa zajednicom, sa klinikama, institucijama za sprovođenje zakona i ostalim partnerima, te sa marginalizovanim i ranjivim stanovništvom, siromašnom populacijom, migrantima i drugim raseljenim licima, mladima, djevojkama, seksualnim radnicima/cama, te osobama koje koriste opojna sredstva, gej populacijom i muškarcima koji imaju seks sa muškarcima i transrodnim osobama, a sve u cilju podsticanja socijalne jednakosti.

4. Iskoristićemo odgovor na AIDS za pozitivnu društvenu transformaciju

Pod našim vođstvom ćemo iskoristiti inovativnu društvenu transformaciju da izgradimo društva koja su pravedna, inkluzivna, prilagodljiva, otporna i održiva. Integrisaćemo zdravstvene i socijalne programe za poboljšanje pružanja usluga, uključujući HIV, tuberkulozu, virusni hepatitis i druge bolesti. Koristićemo napredak u nauci, tehnologiji i zajednicama za pokretanje društvene transformacije, u okviru napora da se osigura jednak pristup obrazovanju.

5. Izgradićemo i ubrzati adekvatan odgovor koji odražava lokalne potrebe

Razvijaćemo i promovisati usluge koje su inovativne, sigurne i dostupne bez ikakve stigmati i diskriminacije, ohrabrićemo i podsticati vođstvo zajednice da izgradi

2. Put people at the centre of everything we do

We will focus our efforts on all people who are vulnerable to HIV, tuberculosis, viral hepatitis and other diseases. We will help to realize and respect the human rights of all affected people and leave no one behind in our city's AIDS, tuberculosis and viral hepatitis response. We will meaningfully include people living with HIV in decision-making around policies and programmes that affect their lives. We will act locally and in partnership with our communities to galvanize global support for healthy and resilient societies and for sustainable development.

3. Address the causes of risk, vulnerability and transmission

We will use all means, including municipal ordinances, policies and programmes, to address factors that make people vulnerable to HIV and other diseases, including laws that discriminate against or criminalize key populations. We will ensure that people affected by HIV enjoy equal participation in civil, political, social, economic and cultural life, free from prejudice, stigma, discrimination, violence or persecution. We will work closely with communities, clinical and service providers, law enforcement and other partners, and with marginalized and vulnerable populations, including slum dwellers, migrants and other displaced people, young women, sex workers, people who use drugs, gay men and other men who have sex with men and transgender people, to foster social equity.

4. Use our AIDS response for positive social transformation

Our leadership will leverage innovative social transformation to build societies that are equitable, inclusive, responsive, resilient and sustainable. We will integrate health and social programmes to improve the delivery of services, including for HIV, tuberculosis, viral hepatitis and other diseases. We will use advances in science, technology and communication to drive the social transformation agenda, including within the context of efforts to ensure equal access to education and learning.

5. Build and accelerate an appropriate response reflecting local needs

We will develop and promote services that are innovative, safe, accessible, equitable and free from stigma and discrimination. We will encourage and foster community leadership to build demand for, and

Prilagodit ćemo naše lokalne planove i resurse za brzo reagovanje na HIV, tuberkulozu, virusni hepatitis i druga oboljenja u kontekstu integrisanog javnog zdravstvenog pristupa. Razvićemo inovativne strategije finansiranja i mobilizovati dodatne resurse za okončanje epidemije AIDS-a do 2030. godine.

7. Ujedinićemo se kao vođe

Obavezujemo se da ćemo razviti akcioni plan za naš grad koji će pratiti fast-track, prihvatiti transparentnu upotrebu podataka kako bismo se smatrali odgovornim i kako bi se pridružili mreži gradova koji učestvuju u izradi Pariske Deklaracije. Radeći uz konsultovanje svih koji su zainteresovani, redovno ćemo mjeriti svoje rezultate i prilagođavati odgovore da budu brži, pametniji i efikasniji. Podržavaćemo druge gradove i dijeliti naša iskustva, saznanja i podatke o tome što funkcioniše i što se može poboljšati. Podnosićemo godišnje izvještaje o našem napretku.




6. Mobilize resources for integrated public health and sustainable development




7. Unite as leaders
